Something to Celebrate at TattsBet

93% of employees who voted in the ballot for the new TattsBet Limited Administration and Customer Services Collective Agreement 2012 have said YES to a new Agreement at TattsBet.

Concluding marathon negotiations, your ASU Delegates, Kim Sunarjana and Peggy Maher endorsed the final draft of the Agreement to go out to ballot. Meetings were held, management agreed to paid time meetings for employees to hear your Union speak on the merits and difficulties of the Agreement and the votes have been counted.

This Agreement signals a commitment from TattsBet management to ensure that employees in each of the new roster categories will be treated equitably and there will be mechanisms in place to ensure this is the case.

While not all things in the Agreement go the employees' way, such as the possible introduction of monthly pays for permanent employees, the overall Agreement is a big step forward.

What Happens Next?

Applications to Fair Work Australia (FWA) are being prepared for the Agreement to be tested against the Better Off Overall Test (BOOT) and once this has occurred and Fair Work approves the Agreement it will commence operation 7 days from that approval date. TattsBet will advise when your wage increases and back pay will be paid after the approval process is finalised.

Work on the changes to roster categories and implementation of the Agreement will then commence with your Union and TattsBet management meeting to work through the set up and changeover of these processes.
