

Auscript Enterprise Bargaining

Auscript staff would be aware that the *Auscript Australasia Enterprise Agreement 2010* expires on 30th June 2013. The ASU is covered by the agreement on behalf of members.

Your enterprise agreement is a legally enforceable document which provides you with wages and conditions specific to Auscript. The relevant underpinning modern award that applies is the *Clerks – Private Sector Award 2010*.

To ensure that you get the most out of the bargaining process you should look carefully at the current agreement and think about what you would like to see improved.

The union's bargaining claims need local members' input but generally involve the following:

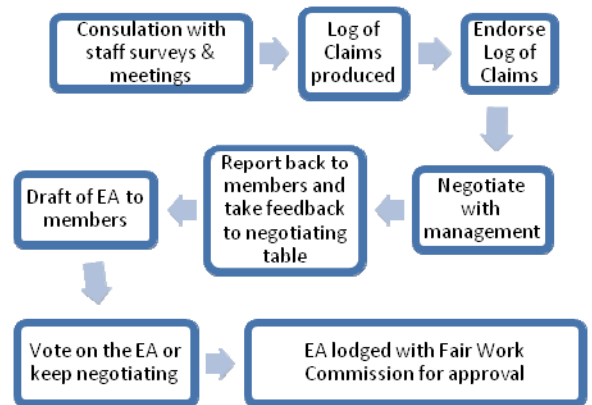
- Annual pay increases
- Classifications based on competence/experience not daily/weekly performance.
- Union consultation
- Job Security
- Hours of Work, penalty rates and overtime
- Full time conversion
- Career Development
- Staffing Levels/Workload
- Improved Superannuation
- Domestic Violence leave
