



## WHAT DO YOU KNOW ABOUT CCTV?

**An international airline has used footage captured by the Brisbane Airport Corporation (BAC) CCTV cameras against an employee with the potential outcome for the employee being unfair dismissal.**

It is clearly understood by all workers at either the domestic or international terminals that the security measures in place are there to defend the security of our borders, aviation security and customs breaches.

***Did you know that your employer can just ask BAC to view this CCTV footage with no connection to anything related to aviation security or customs breaches?***

***Did you know that your employer could access this footage and use it against you in relation to your work performance?***

Your ASU representatives have sought clarification from BAC as to the authority they have to provide access to view footage captured on the CCTV by any tenant of the airport for matters not related to aviation security or customs breaches. When we have their response we shall provide you with the details.

In the meanwhile, the ASU continues to represent our member who has been deeply affected by the steps the company has taken. We will vigorously defend our member against any actions the company takes as we believe the CCTV footage shown provided no evidence of any wrong doing.

**It is important that you know your rights. The concerns surrounding how these very legitimate sources of security measures can be used against you in your day to day work are very complex.**
