

Your Blue Care Agreements are ready to be voted on

All Blue Care allied health and clerical and administrative employees should be aware that the voting process for your next collective agreement has commenced.

The process starts with rounds of consultation meetings conducted by management and the opportunity for you to review the Agreements prior to the voting period commencing.

Your union recommends the Agreements you vote yes.

The negotiation process has been long and included the potential of action in Fair Work, the joining of negotiations into a single joint agreement, union members winning the separation of that agreement to return to their current state which ensures the particulars of the clerical and administrative agreement and the specialties of the allied health agreement remain protected.

There will be multiple meetings conducted across the clusters. Union representatives will attend as many of these meetings where possible.
