QUEENSLAND TOGETHER BRANCH VACANCY ELECTION NOTICE 2017

Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009

The Delegate of the General Manager of the Fair Work Commission has made arrangements with the Australian Electoral Commission for elections to be conducted for the offices listed below.

- **Nominations**, which must be in writing and comply with the organisation's registered rules, may be made at any time from Friday 11 August 2017 and must reach my office or postal address **not later than 12 Noon (AEST) on Friday 1 September 2017**. Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 12 Noon (AEST) on **Friday 8 September 2017**.
- **Nomination Forms** for both Individual and Team Nominations are available from the Returning Officer or the registered office of the organisation. The use of these forms is not compulsory provided that nominations comply with the rules.

In addition to Individual Nominations National Rule 40.f allows for a group of eligible members to nominate as members of a "Team Nomination", which must have a name.

National Rule 40.f.ii states - *The name of a Team nomination must not be the same as or similar to the name of another Team Nomination or the name of any member of another Team Nomination or be deceptive of any other way.*

A team nomination must nominate an eligible (or required number of people) for each position for which nominations have been called whereupon each person will be considered to have nominated for each position concerned.

Note: Rule 41(C)(ii & iii) states if a member has nominated for more than one full time office or on the same Conference, Executive, Council or other body within the Union, or is nominated for the office of Member and Alternative Member, or for more than one Office of Alternative Member, of the same Conference, Executive, Council or other body, such member must, within seven days (7) after the close of nominations, advise the Returning Officer in writing which one of such positions the member wishes to stand for, and withdraw any nomination or nominations for the other offices for which the said member was nominated, failing which, the Returning Officer shall reject all the nominations for offices

- **Ballot:** If a ballot is required ballot material will be posted on Friday 29 September 2017 to eligible members at the address shown in the Union's records. The ballot will close at 10 am (AEST) on Friday 20 October 2017.

Members should notify the Union of any change of address.
