Negotiations for a new agreement for JTG Services staff has officially commenced with your ASU-JTG National Negotiating Team (NNT) holding their first negotiation meeting with management in Melbourne on 29th May 2012.

What happened at the negotiations?

Management, who were represented by Andrea Slark, Matthew Harcombe and consultant Justine Oldmeadow, gave an overview of the operation of the business and how things have been travelling recently.

Your NNT then tabled our list of issues/claims which we compiled by reviewing all the ASU surveys that had been completed by staff and by getting feedback from staff in our recent meetings. Our claims represent the issues that we were told were the most important to achieve in our new agreement.

We gave the company reps a brief overview of our claims which we will go into more detail about at our next meetings. The list of claims we gave to the company is available from your local ASU organiser or delegate/representative.
