



Toll Dnata – Weststaff employees

IMPORTANT NEWS

Were you employed by Weststaff when the Toll Dnata Passenger Services Agreement came into effect on 28th October, 2011?

Did you know that even though you were employed by Weststaff at the time, Toll Dnata made a commitment in their Agreement that any contracted staff would be paid the same as Toll Dnata staff? (*see clause 2.2 Labour Hire Personnel*).

The ASU has investigated what this means for our members. Right now we can tell you that if Toll Dnata had stuck to the word of their Agreement which is legally binding, then Weststaff would have had to pay you at the Toll Dnata rates between the date the Agreement came into effect on the 28th October, 2011 and the date your employment transferred from Weststaff to Toll Dnata.

Our investigations have shown that ASU members could be entitled to a wages claim in excess of \$1500.00 depending on the shifts you worked. If you were employed by Weststaff on the 28th October, 2011 and are now employed by Toll Dnata, this could be you.

You need to join the ASU now. Only ASU members will have their wages claims investigated by the union and where possible acted upon.
