Is QDI Negotiating in Good Faith?

A key benefit of being a member of the ASU is that you have access to industrial and strategic advice when it is time to renegotiate your wages and conditions through enterprise bargaining.

That time is now and you should be concerned because:

- Your Enterprise Agreement expired at the end of June 2013;
- Negotiations first commenced in December 2013;
- QDI say upfront NO to any backpayments; and
- QDI have not responded to ASU Log of Claims.

The Fair Work Act requires that the parties negotiate in good faith and the ASU is concerned that negotiations are not proceeding efficiently or fairly.

So, who acts in your best interest?

If not for the ASU to defend your rights, then who?

Without fair negotiations in place, there is a real danger that your conditions are placed at risk. Your conditions should not randomly be negotiated away.

What can you do?

Send an email to your QDI State Manager: info@qld.asu.net.au to say:

- it's not right for QDI to delay negotiations.
- It's not right for QDI to delay your future wage increases.
- It's not right for QDI to place your conditions at work at risk.

To help Safe guard your conditions at work, make sure you support and are a member of the ASU.

What the ASU is doing ...

We have made an application to the Fair Work Commission to get Bargaining Orders to:

- instruct QDI to come back to the negotiating table and meet with the ASU;
- instruct QDI to respond to our Log of Claims;
- instruct QDI to provide all relevant information in regards to their separate meetings with other bargaining representatives;
- instruct QDI to outline what their Log of Claims are so we can respond.
