The LATEST POST on VOTING UP Your New BlueCare EBA.

Alert to all Administrative and Allied Health working for BlueCare.

With VOTING on both Enterprise Agreements OPEN, staff were told.

- Voting process would be by postal vote;
- Ballot papers to be posted out to employee's home address;
- Voting opens 13 March, 2014;
- Voting closes 26 March, 2014; and
- Votes will be counted on 26 March, 2014.

What we have learned this week following many complaints from members is that BlueCare staff still have not received their Ballot Papers.

The Australian Services Union/Together has alerted BlueCare to this fact.

We also asked BlueCare to extend the closing date to allow staff sufficient time for staff to post back and have their voting papers received and counted by the Organisation on Wednesday 26 March 2014.

At this juncture BlueCare refuse and insist the Ballot will close 26 March 2014.

Therefore as soon as you receive your Ballot papers you need to immediately vote and **POST BACK IMMEDIATELY** to BlueCare to ensure your vote is counted on the 26th March, 2014.

Alternatively, if you do not receive a Ballot Paper or if by the time you got it, you believed it would be impossible for BlueCare to have received your Vote before the 26th March, 2014 - **you need to let us know urgently by emailing: info@qld.asu.net.au** or by calling the union office on **1800 177 244**.

Your Union will then take the matter up with Blue Care and, if necessary, escalate accordingly.
