Re: Application for exemption from holding an election [Matter no. RJO/2015/124]

I refer to an application filed in the Industrial Registry on 10 November 2015 by Together Queensland, Industrial Union of Employees [TQ] for exemption under section 580 of the *Industrial Relations Act 1999* from holding an election for stated offices.

It is noted that no objections to the application have been lodged in the Registry.

TQ is an employee organisation registered under the *Industrial Relations Act 1999*. Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union is an employee organisation registered under the *Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009* [C'wealth]. I have perused the affidavit of Alexander Patrick Scott and the rules of each of the organisations and am satisfied that the Queensland Together Branch of the Australian Municipal, Administrative, Clerical and Services Union is a counterpart federal body of TQ within the meaning of s. 411 of the *Industrial Relations Act 1999*.

Being satisfied as required by section 580(2) of the *Industrial Relations Act 1999*, on 23 December 2015 I granted TQ exemption from holding an election for the stated offices, in accordance with the Australian Electoral Commission election results declared on 15 May 2015, 8 September 2015 and 21 October 2015 for election numbered E2014/279, as follows:
