Nominations, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Branch, may be made at any time from 18/06/2018 until nominations close at 12:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) on 09/07/2018.

All candidates must be nominated by two members of the Union who are financial members to and by the end of the month preceding the calling of nominations, with the candidate's consent in writing.

In addition to the qualifications for nominators set out above, only members allocated to an Industry Division, Sub Branch, Section, District, Zone or any other subordinate part created by or in a Branch pursuant to the rules, may nominate candidates for offices for which the members of such Industry Division, Sub Branch, Section, District, Zone or subordinate part, form the sole electorate. Provided that this sub-rule shall not apply to offices which are nominated pursuant to sub-rule 40(g) hereof. (ASU National Rule 40(e)&(j))

Nomination forms are available from the Returning Officer, the Branch Office of the Qld Together Branch or the AEC Website.

They must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than** 12:00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST) **on** 09/07/2018.
