

Good afternoon

We appreciate the opportunity to consult yesterday with TQ representatives on TMRs IVMS as it relates to CSB.

Following our meeting and TQ's request to turn off the Safety Reporting for the Transport Inspectors within CSB, I can now provide the following:

I confirm Anna Jack has arranged the temporary disablement (effective from yesterday afternoon, Wednesday 30 September) of Manager/Administrator safety reporting access (including driver safety and behaviour) for all CSB vehicles. Drivers within CSB will continue to receive notifications of any events that occur. Anna's team will centrally monitor any safety events that occur within the CSB branch.

Additionally the team will work with WHS Corporate on Driver Safety information that can be shared with CSB teams to assist in educating and reminding staff of the importance of Driver Safety at a group level where we see breaches of safety events.

This approach will remain in place until through consultation and until we have an agreed approach on the IVMS Policy/Procedure.

As requested I have sent through an invitation for the next planned IVMS consultation meeting with a number of other unions engaged across TMR.
